Ogden: Tuesday, November 18, 2025 at age 80. Predeceased by her husband, Lawrence. Survived by her children, Michelle (William) Currie, Scott (Meggan) Jermyn and Kelly (Alberto) Montanez; grandchildren, Christian (Marija) and Brooke Montanez; sister, Emily Bradley; and many nieces, nephews and dear friends.

Toni moved to Rochester, New York from Puerto Rico with her family at the age of 5 years old, a part of the first major wave of Puerto Rican families settling in the area. She was a devout Catholic, attending Catholic schools from Kindergarten, through her graduation from Mercy High School in 1964. Toni married her high school sweetheart, Larry, in 1965, together, raising their 3 children in Gates, New York. She dedicated her life to working as a case worker, working with migrants, refugees, in women's health, and becoming one of the first case workers in the area to support individuals living with and impacted by HIV/AIDS. Her devotion to helping others was unparalleled and came from a place of true caring and love for those underserved. Toni was an amazing mother, grandmother, and friend. She was a popular and known face at all of her grandchildren's sporting, dance and school events. There were no "strangers" to her and anyone who had the honor to meet her experienced an immediate feeling of welcoming and warmth. To those a part of her life, her family, neighbors, friends from childhood, adulthood, and to newer friends from her St. Ann's Community, thank you. Thank you for loving

her and thank you for being a part of who she was.
