Churchville - Chris passed away January 28, 2016 at her home after a brave fight with cancer. Chris was the daughter of Robert and Lois McCabe of Fayetteville NY. Chris earned her bachelor's degree from SUNY Brockport and did her student teaching in the Spencerport School district where she was immediately hired to teach first grade. She retired from Spencerport after 32 years, and 835 students. Chris entered the Associate program of the Sisters of Mercy in 1982 and purchased a home on Orchard St in North Chili where she and Sister Carol Fox ran a "Sisters of Mercy House of Hospitality". During their time there they helped many displaced people find their way to a better life.

After she retired from teaching, she volunteered at St. Mary's Oncology where she became a dedicated and dependable aid to those treating people fighting cancer. Chris took a position with St. Christopher Church in 2004 as a Pastoral Minister where she touched countless lives with visits to hospitals, nursing homes, shut-ins and anyone who needed a spiritual lift.
