Elisa May LaCourse Martin, 52, of Churchville, New York, passed away suddenly on May 15, 2024. Born to William and Patricia (Clarke) LaCourse, of Alfred, New York, Elisa was a beloved daughter, mother, sister, and community leader.

Elisa graduated Magna Cum Laude from Alfred University, earning Bachelor of Science degrees in Health Care Planning and Management and in Business Administration, a strong foundation for a distinguished career in both the medical and financial sectors. She put both degrees to work, first as team leader in planning individual patient care in the Brain Injury Unit at St. Mary's Hospital then Biovail Pharmaceuticals, and GlaxoSmithKline Pharmaceuticals. Elisa's dedication to improving healthcare was evident in her work and the lives she touched.

Seeking new challenges, Elisa transitioned into financial services, bringing her expertise to Fidelity, M&T Bank, Key Bank, and Prudential. Her commitment to excellence and her ability to connect with her clients helped her thrive in this industry.

Community involvement was very important to Elisa. She was President of the Gates Chili Chamber of Commerce, served on the Churchville Town Planning Board, and acted as an ambassador for Rodan + Fields. Her leadership and dedication were instrumental in driving community initiatives and supporting

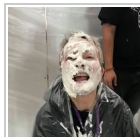
