January 19, 1955 - October 2, 2023

Went to be with the Lord Jesus on Monday, October 2, 2023 at age 68, in his home surrounded by his family. Survived by his loving wife of 39 years, Nancy (Reagan); children, Jennifer (Jake) Phillips, Ryan (Heidi), Nathan and Kristin (Colby) Stratton; grandchildren, Ethan Phillips and Finley Boland; brother, Robert (Jacalyn); niece, Shannon Boland; mother-in-law, Valerie Fingland; and many beloved extended family members.

Gary was born on January 19, 1955 where he grew up in the 19th Ward of Rochester, NY and later moved to Greece, NY. He lived with his father, mother, older brother and later on his two cousins and grew up with a large extended family. He went on to graduate from Greece Arcadia High School where he was active in many sports but especially football. At the age of 19 he went to work at Kodak where he invested 45 years supporting his family. He accepted Christ into his life at the age of 25 and started attending Open Door Baptist Church in 1980. His entrance into the church was also where he met his wife Nancy in 1981 and later married in 1983. Between 1986 and 1993 Gary and Nancy welcomed four children: Jennifer, Ryan, Nathan, and Kristin. A majority of Gary's time went to church ministry, youth athletics, supporting his children, family weekends at Keuka lake, and being a mentor to many.

I wear his memory like an invisible tattoo on my arm, a constant reminder of how family, and his presence in my life, made me me feel secure and part of something much bigger than myself. I carried this with me throughout life, and although I wasn’t able to see Gary during my adult years he was always with me in my heart. I’m so grateful that I was able to spend time with Gary on my visits home in 2016 and 2018. He was so exuberant, so full of life and clearly enjoying every minute of it. We had a riotous time recalling family members and our impressions of them when we were children. He was just so much fun to be with, and I was looking forward to spending more time with him when I visited again. Unfortunately the pandemic prevented me from doing that. Now we’re all sharing hm with the Lord, but I’m sure Gary is looking down at all of us from Heaven and still having a laugh. He won’t be resting, and he definitely won’t be peaceful, but he’ll be livening up the crowd with his wit and his charm. I will always hold a special love for him in my heart.

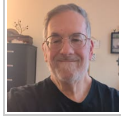
