Lois Brown Wing, 77, died unexpectedly in North Chili, NY.

Lois had a very special connection to music and was a talented vocalist. In college, she entered and won a talent contest. She shared her love of music through the gift of lullabies and playing sing-song games with her children and grandchildren. She performed in countless choir productions with her church. Music was a source of comfort and connection for Lois.

Lois was predeceased by her husband, Dick. We miss her already, but smile knowing they are reunited again in heaven.
