Lyle D. Hibbard passed away suddenly on August 12, 2025. He then pastored a church in Kansas before returning to Practical Bible, where he taught for 7 years. In 1984, Lyle moved to Rochester, NY, working at the Department of Social Services for a few years, where he met Maureen before ultimately starting & finishing his career with the Monroe County Sheriff’s Department as a Sheriff’s Deputy in the civil bureau for 20 years. Lyle is the oldest person on record to complete the police academy at the age of 56.

Lyle was very active in his church, Northridge Church in Rochester. He loved to travel & was an avid Boston Celtics & Buffalo Bills fan, but what he loved most was spending time with his family. Lyle loved the Lord with all his heart & he loved discussing & teaching Scripture. Lyle was kind, had a huge heart, &
