Marcia N. Marks, age 75, of Rochester, NY passed away peacefully on November 20, 2023.

Marcia was born to Mabel (“Biddy”) and Andrew Pechie on April 16, 1948, and lived in Rochester her whole life. She attended Monroe High School and worked for Chili Recreation for over 25 years.

She was a strong advocate for people with disabilities and was instrumental in the development of the Chili Challenge Baseball program.
