“ What I can say about Richie will be too long for this platform but I will drop a tidbit. His nicknames were, "Willo", "The second richest man in The Rochie", "Richie", "Rich Money", "Richie Rich" and "Rich" each having it's own relevance. His favorite nickname for me was, "RAW Enterprises". His Mercedes was "The Merk" and his city of Rochester was "The Rochie". After owning the Merk he told me to never buy a Mercedes and he would never own another one either. Often our talks began with his "rant" which could go on for about 10 minutes and once he got it all out, he would declare, "That was my rant for the day" and we would then talk about our day or our current issues. When he worked for the medical billing company his lunch time was his "lunch moment" and our code name for Saidah was "Little One". Europe and Alabama were our next 2 trips for 2023 but illness took them away. Brooklyn was a place he longed to live in again and we were planning to be world citizens, spending days and weeks away from home in the near future. He couldn't stand fake people and did his best to keep his word. He liked the Buffalo Bills only after I encouraged him in American Football and going to a game was on the list of things we wanted to do. We also wanted to go back to Canada and visit the crew; Allison and her mom, Aunty Juney and her son, Merrell and Arlene, and see some more of Toronto/Canada. We talked on the phone almost daily and some days were more than once. Before I was remarried it was daily but we eased up once I was married. My wife Maria would always know when I was on the phone with Richard because of the way we talked to each other. He could be articulate, and he could be street if needed. Three things about my friend that I want you to know. Richard was private and so there are things he disclosed that I will never be at liberty to disclose and there were times he would be doing something or speaking to someone on the phone and he would not reveal who or what. I respected that and I learned to leave it alone until he shared it with me. Richard was loyal. His commitment to Saidah was at the highest level that I have ever seen for a father. I believe that Nicole's passing drove him into these first 2 areas of his personality more than anything else, and he gave everything for Little One. Finally, Richard was ready. We

spoke ad nauseum about death and life, and the frailty of it all. That was one of the reasons he allowed me to lead him to the cross of Christ; he knew his maker needed his life. He had been making plans to serve in the kingdom before this illness stepped in. It did not stop Richard, it transitioned Richard, to Nicole, his parents and those who he had missed for so long. This year was a wake-up call, the surgery was a wake-up call, the ensuing life changes were a wake-up call and I am glad to know that on November 9th sometime after 3:41pm, he woke up in the presence of Almighty God with the angels and his loved ones. Rest with God my friend and we will see each other again.
