Rochester- Victoria T. Romig died August 30, 2025 aged 97, at The Jewish Home of Rochester.

Born April 8, 1928, in New York City to Clifton S. and Charlotte D. Thomson. She was the older sister of Charlotte D. Thomson (Iserbyt).

Victoria earned a BA from Barnard College in New York City in May 1950. She met David W. Romig, a Union Seminary student, and they were married June 2, 1951.

Vicky, as her friends called her, supported David's career as a Presbyterian minister. David's first assignment was at the Riverdale Presbyterian Church. Next, he was called to the Sea & Land church on the Lower East Side where he and Vicky raised seven children. The family of 9 moved to Brighton in Rochester, NY in '68 when David was called to Brick Church on Fitzhugh St. The church is now known as the Downtown United Presbyterian Church. She was a gifted pianist and shared her musical talent as a volunteer at Monroe Community Hospital. She and David collaborated on the music for several theatre productions at the Downtown United Presbyterian Church. She was also an avid writer and had many opinion pieces published in Rochester's local newspapers.

Vicky and David spent their summers on Grand Manan Island in New Brunswick Canada. Their experiences there entertaining family and friends in a ruggedly beautiful environment brought them great joy through the years.

Vicky and David nurtured their children's many interests with unwavering support. She is survived by David T. Romig, Diana R. Mellin, Sarah W. Fitts-Romig, Victoria R. Storrie, Ella R. Madlen, Clifton S. Romig, and John S. Romig. She had 10 grandchildren and five great-grandchildren.
